

TREASURER'S REPORT ...

As we see March pass, I certainly hope that April brings dry and warmer weather. The current lake is jagged with strong westerlies, the harbor is dotted with Bufflehead's as well as other cold climate foul and it is still cold.

It's hard to believe that we are only five weeks away from opening our 2019 season. Things will begin to ramp up quickly with spring building freshening and before we know it, we will be bellying up to the bar for a cold draft or dining on one of Julie's great meals.

To get your ready, the Board has approved once again to offer a "*Prepay*" opportunity to put funds on your House Account. This offers the House cash flow for startup as well as rewarding members with a little bonus. Last year's program had both positive and negative results, so some adjustments were made to make it a positive for both parties. The change made is that this year's credit will be 3%. The particulars of this offer are as follows:

- Prepayment limits: \$1000 Maximum, \$100 Minimum
- Bonus <u>3%</u> credit of your payment will be applied to your house account (example: pay \$1000 and receive extra \$30).
- Payment <u>MUST</u> be received between April 1 28, 2019. No exceptions
- This is voluntary
- Must be used in 2019 open season (May Oct).
 No refunds or cash exchange
- Make payment to "OYC House Account". Please
 DO NOT include it in the same check as your dues payments, if they are still owed.
- This offer is not available to any current outstanding
 House accounts

Think of it as a few free drinks or meals on us. I know my check will be in the mail tomorrow.

As a reminder, your 2019 dues payments are due April 1st. To ensure that your charging privileges will be available come opening day, please get them in as soon as possible. As noted in the Secretaries article please get any changes in the directory to me as soon as possible.

Youth Boating & Sailing Program (a) Olcott's Lake Ontario Sponsored by Olcott Yacht Club

The Olcott Yacht Club's Junior Sailing program is a summer sailing camp which began in the mid 1940's and today is still an important part of the Club and community. Over the years we have served many families and children as they enjoyed learning to sail and taking with them lifetime skills and friendships. Our program provides general sailing instruction for both boys and girls ages 7 to 18, non-members and members alike. Our training is done in both Optimist dinghy's and Club 420's providing an ample fleet of boats for both beginner sailors and returning veterans. Our advanced racers are known around the lake to be great competitors and true sportsmen.





Several levels of instruction are taught with an emphasis on safety, fun, sportsmanship, cooperation and competition. The curriculum follows the US Sailing Association format and our instructional staff (many of whom went through the program themselves) are all US Sailing and American Red Cross certified. Classes are kept small with a student/teacher ratio of less than 10:1. We are adding kayaking, canoeing and paddle boarding this season.

We continue to do our best to provide an instructional experience that is reasonable in cost to each family. In order to be able to provide & maintain all of our boats & equipment used, beyond the income from camp tuition, we rely on generous financial support and fundraising from The Olcott Mantel Club; our past commodores organization which is a 501 (c) 3 charitable organization. Through their annual fundraiser and tax-deductible donations we continue to keep our program a success.


