

The Junior Sailing 2025 application and fee schedule is up on the Olcottyachtclub.com website. Happy to say our 2024 staff is returning with Head Instructor: Ella Thibault, Instructors: Gabe Ferreira, Talia Ferreira, and Sienna Bowers. We are adopting a little more focused program with an emphasis on an "Adventure Sail" component with emphasis on pleasure and leisure sailing and a "Racing" component with emphasis on competition. 
