#### COMMODORE'S MESSAGE

We are in full swing with our club house open Wednesday through Sunday. Racing has started as has the Adult Sailing class run by Justin Naylor. As I write this almost all of our stored boats are in the water. Our thanks to the haul out crew for all the work they do to make that happen. Haul out has been our biggest source of revenue and we should all make sure the crew receives the credit they deserve for keeping this efficiently operating.

This year marks the final year of our agreement with Jane Voeple for the four club slips which have served us so well allowing boats over 30 ft a dock in the harbor. The trees along that bank had become a hazard and it was time to either cut them down or give up the docks. Since there are now an abundance of slips in the harbor it seems we no longer need to continue our lease on the property. The decision to end the lease was mutually agreed to.

The board has voted to take down the stairway and deck outside the Commodore's Porch. The stairs are quite unsteady, and the deck needs to be replaced. It was felt that since the deck has rarely been used in the past it was not worth spending several thousand dollars to repair it. A sign and barrier have been placed at the base of the stairway as it has been determined they are not safe to use. Please respect both the sign and barrier. We plan to put an additional barrier up to stop entry to the area from the Commodore's Porch but still allow the doors to be opened for ventilation.

The siding on the south end of the building is scheduled to start mid-July. We have procured 4 members to loan us \$2500 each to do the project. They will be paid back when Niagara County cuts us a check from the Facade Grant funds.

I want to extend a big thank you to Doug Wintersteen for inviting club members to hear his son's band which played for Doug and Bonnie's 50 anniversary. The band is out of New York City and were absolutely fabulous. Quite a few members took advantage of the invitation, and everyone agreed the band put on a great show.

#### Treasurer's Report

Our season is in full swing as we enter July. I want to start by reminding the membership that the Club is "CASHLESS". We do not accept cash from you or your guests at the time of payment for rest/bar service. We accept Mastercard or VISA for payment or your member house account. The only exception are certain special events (Comm. Ball, 3rd of July, Boil Bash, Oktoberfest, Trophy Night).

May monthly invoices were emailed at the beginning of June. Since we are using Quickbooks online now, this is the most efficient way to get invoices/statements to you. I did find that a few emails were incorrect, so that has been corrected and those invoices were re sent. For anyone with an outstanding balance as of June 20th, a reminder email was sent that payment is due.

June invoices will be done the first week of July so watch your email. If you still have a credit or owe for May charges, you will also receive a statement. Overall amount owed will be on the statement. To avoid this confusion, simply pay your house bill when you receive it as it is due upon receipt. It is critical to our operation and we appreciate those who are always on time.

I'm hoping this next billing goes a bit smoother as we are still transitioning to the new software. Payment is still to be sent as a check from your bank (set up OYC as a payee) or by a personal check mailed. I will also accept monthly payments by check/cash if I am at the Club. The bartenders can't accept them. Just text and I will make sure I am around.

One last thing, July is the last month in our first quarter for the \$75 House Quarterly Minimum. 
